## ABOUT THE PANEL

Students spend on average \$484 on textbooks annually, but surprisingly, this number is actually decreasing because of a growing collection of open educational resources, better utilization of library collections, and the availability of tools that allow faculty to create their own content. In this panel, a Northeastern librarian will introduce Leganto, a tool for easy integration of resources that the library owns. Attendees will also hear about the library's open educational resource initiative, which provides support for adopting open educational resources in place of commercial textbooks. Finally, a panelist will present on the process by which she made her own interactive text book using university tools and shared her content with colleagues teaching the same course.
